Program Description

The Department of Pediatric Dentistry at the University of Florida and Collier Health Services, Inc. are jointly recruiting 3 applicants for a new pediatric dental residency program in Naples, FL as a satellite site of the pediatric dentistry program in Gainesville, FL. The didactic and clinical curriculum follows the same standards in use for the residency program at the University of Florida in Gainesville.

The residency program provides care to an underserved community in one of the fastest growing areas in the nation. As a Center for Excellence in pediatric dentistry, this program includes a new state-of-the-art facility and an innovative community outreach with a public health and preventive orientation.

Long distance learning technology has been extensively used for seminars and advanced courses. Medical rotations and Hospital-based training are performed at the Collier Health Care Services Network and the Lee Memorial Hospital, located in Fort Myers.

This newly established site falls under the current pediatric dentistry program accreditation umbrella; however, it is not fully accredited until the site visit occurs on June 5, 2009.

A stipend in the amount of \$35,000.00 is provided. No tuition is required.

Application is through PASS. This program participates in the MATCH. Deadline for application is October 1st, 2009.
