Program deadline: September 1, 2009
Required number of evaluation forms: 2
- D.M.D./D.D.S. degree, or equivalent from an International Dental School
- A citizen of the United States, a permanent resident of the US or in the process of becoming a permanent resident (I-551, I-551C, I-130, I-94) (No student or visitor VISAS accepted)
- Passed Parts I and II, National Dental Board Examination
- Scored at least an 80 on the TOEFL
